Autobiography

My name is Ivan. I'm 33 years old. I was born in Cherkasy region, Ukraine. I'm married. My wife is 34 years old. She works as a technologist at the poultry farm. We have two daughters, Maria and Daria, 6 and 3 years old. They are lovely, energetic and kind-hearted kids.
