# Autobiography

My name is Dmytro. I was born in 1989 in the village in Khmelnytskyi region, Ukraine. My family is engaged in agriculture. My father Anatolii is a farmer. He has a farm where we have 150 pigs and my mother Nataliia is a housewife. My sister is a manager. In September 25 last year I got married, my wife's name is Iryna, she's a cook. I don't have children yet.

I have good English language and speak Ukrainian and Russian. I have a driving license and can drive a car and truck too. I can do welding, I can to work with different power tools too

I have started my secondary school education in 1995 and finished in 2006. Since school years I have been surrounded with animals and agrarian lifestyle. I was always keen on agriculture and gardening, as we lived in a private house with a plot of land. We grow different vegetables ( tomatoes, potatoes, cucumbers, carrots ). We have a beautiful orchard with apple, plum, apricot and cherry trees always helped my parents on the farm, vegetable garden and fruit garden. At that time my hobby appeared. It is growing exotic plants such as lemons, I like fishing and sport too.

After school I started to work at the father's farm where we breed pigs. We also have a small (15 ha) field where we grow corn, wheat, barley etc. At the father's farm I got great experience in breeding animals, agronomic crops and driving vehicles ( tractor, trucks).

In July 2010 I went to work to another pig farm. I wanted to see how other farmers work and breed pigs. I worked for 2 years. There I did

- feeding, cleaning and disinfecting of boxes,
- taking care of piglets,
- castration, cutting tails,
- insemination,
- giving injections and medicines.

In August 2012 I decided to see the world and found a job at the international ship. I worked for 8 months as a cleaner there.

In 2013 I entered Agrarian Lyceum, the faculty of veterinary. I studied for 2 years. After the graduation I helped my father with his farm and looked for a job abroad.

From 1 April 2016 to 1 April 2017 I worked at a pig farm in the USA North Dakota town Cando. Enterprise Sky Can, farm "Hexagon LLP & Dakota Country Swine LLP". It cooperates with HyLife from Canada. The production includes 6000 heads of sows, 500 gilts and 30 boars. Also they have 10000 – 12000 piglets. Every day we had many jobs. We started to work at 5:30.

We fed sows then we checked every sow. After we began to check gilts before insemination of them.

I worked at a breeding station but also I gave injections, checked pregnant sows after 25 and 50 days, loaded and unloaded trucks with sows,

checked gilts, washed rooms after old sows before coming of new gilts, made tags, moved sows.

Every day we moved sows from farrow rooms to the breeding station and back. We moved every day a lot sows because we checked who is pregnant and who is not.

Some times I drove a bobcat for moving of dead sows and piglets from farm to the incinerator.

I fixed crates, replaced gates, light bulbs, water timer, welded broken gates.

I worked with piglets in a farrow rooms where I cut the tails, did castration, made tags and tattoo.

We had boars and we collected semen every Monday and Thursday.

I completed courses and have got certificates upon participation in the Animal Care & Handling Course, H2S Awareness.

From June 2017 to December 2018 he was in the Ukrainian Army where was at the post engineer. In the army I got a very good experience in the construction of roads and bridges.

Since January 2019 to now I have been working at the same pig farm where I worked earlier.

And I would like to find a job at a pig-breeding farm in Canada. I know that pig industry there is on a high level. I would like to apply my knowledge and experience in Canada. I think it's the best way to expand my outlook, to communicate with international people and to develop my professional skills. .
