## **Autobiography**

My name is Serhii Karakai. I'm 29years old. I was born on the second of March, 1992 in villageStarosillia. I have a small family. My father Vasyl works as a machine operator-tractor driver. My mother Olena is a houswife, and my sister Liubov works as a shop-assistant. I'm not married. My height is 188 cm, weight is 75 kg.

I grew up in the village, so agricultural work is an inseparable part of my daily life. My father has a small family farm which consists of 10 pigs, 5 cows and few calves. Also we have a garden and 2 hectares of the field. I always helped my parents grow vegetables, fruits and looked after the animals. I enjoyed spending time with animals.

After finishing school, I worked on our family farm. But in some years I decided to get the appropriate education in order to be a master of my craft.

In 2018 I entered the Vocational Agrarian Lyceum on the faculty of veterinary and stockbreeding. During studying we combined learning theory and doing practice. We took care of the animals on the training farm, fed and watered them, moved the animals on the pastures and washed the stables. But I wanted to develop my skills further and therefore I decided to find the internship abroad.

From May 2019 to November 2020 I was doing the internship on the dairy farm in Denmark, called as Revslundgaard. The farm comprised 600 milking cows and a lot of calves. My responsibilities included taking daily care about cows and small calves, feeding, cleaning, milking, vaccinating, health monitoring, treating mastitis, cleaning stables and giving straw, moving cows and calves, helping with hoof trimming and other accompanying works. I can also drive a tractor without trailer, loader and skid steer loader of any type.

I have a good level of the English language and understand a little bit of Danish. Also I speak Polish and Russian. My mother tongue is Ukrainian. I have a driving license and can drive a car. As for my hobby I like to play volleyball.

Now, when I have enough experience, I am seeking the opportunity to work as a skilled worker in the sphere of animal husbandry in Norway. Norwegian agriculture is one of the best developed, so I want to adopt the experience of local farmers on the one hand and apply all my gained skills on practice on the other hand.
